
Federal Funds Provided to School Districts In Response to COVID-19

 - Examine current purchases (e.g. reduce timeline for 1:1 device completion)
- How Can We Ensure The Sustainability of New Purchases?
 - Examine effectiveness of new purchases and long-term budget plans beyond 2024
 - Use General Funds To Make Aidable Purchases
