
#### **Program & Capital Components**

Program component includes the fourth year of a multi-year lease agreement for computer network components and the last year of a five year transportation agreement.

Capital component includes the transfer to capital budget for the following:

At the Elementary School: Replace and install pavement, walkways, and '38 cupola windows.

At the High School: Replace and install pavement, walkways and heating control upgrades.

### ABSENTEE BALLOT INFORMATION

#### **PROPOSITION NO. 1**

RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Sullivan West Central School District, Sullivan County, New York, shall be authorized to expend the sum set forth in the budget for the 2023-2024 school year in the total amount of \$41,796,395, and to assess and levy upon the taxable property for the District the necessary tax therefore.

#### **PROPOSITION NO. 2**

Shall the Board of Education of the Sullivan West Central School District be authorized to have a high school senior student serve as an ex-officio non-voting member of the school board, each student to serve a one-year term to begin on July 1st of the current year and to end on June 30th of the following year?

#### **VOTER QUALIFICATIONS**

To be a qualified voter you must be a U.S. Citizen; at least 18 years old by May 16, 2023; a School District resident for 30 days immediately preceding the vote and be registered to vote in School District elections. If a voter is currently registered to vote with the Sullivan County Board of Elections, they are also eligible to vote in this election. All other persons who wish to vote must register with the District Clerk no later than May 11, 2023.
