What do we want to accomplish?

- The primary purpose of our Program & Service Review is to examine:
 - Sullivan West School Programs & Services and their costs
- Items to consider:
 - Approximately 85% of Sullivan West's \$34.9 million budget goes to pay our employees' salaries and benefits; salaries of BOCES employees; 1st Student's employees, and other contracted employees
 - 1% on the tax levy equals \$173,772
 - Average salary with benefits for a teacher is \$113,230
- Question to Ask:
 - Are these the best ways to use the community's resources to educate our students?
