
Program & Capital Components

Program component includes the second year of a multi-year transportation agreement and third year of a multi-year lease agreement for computer network components.

CAPITAL COMPONENT INCLUDES THE TRANSFER TO CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE FOLLOWING:

At the Elementary School:

- Purchase & install a new generator for a self-sustaining emergency shelter;
- Increase the elevation of the finished floor for future maintenance storage building including modification of site, drainage and utilities;
- Design schematics & relocation of new oil tank, provide new pathways for underground fuel piping, disconnect & reconnect existing mechanical equipment.
