Program component includes the third year of a multi-year transportation agreement and first year of a multi-year lease agreement for computer network components.


CAPITAL COMPONENT INCLUDES THE TRANSFER TO CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE FOLLOWING:


At the Elementary School:

From the Board of Education

Dear Sullivan West Community,

Members of the Board of Education, working with Superintendent Dr. Nancy M. Hackett and our Assistant Superintendent for Administrative Services Lornaine Poston, have put significant time and energy into the development of the 2016-2017 School Budget that is outlined for you in this newsletter. As in necent years, it continues to be a difficult process as we make every effort to contain costs yet provide a high quality educational program that prepares our students for the world beyond high school.

An additional challenge that the District faces in the 2016-2017 year is the decrease in the tax revenue. We feel that this budget accomplishes our goal in spite of the mandated requirement that results in a negative tax levy of 2.76%. My colleagues on the Board join me in recommending it to you.

Our Budget Vote will take place on Tuesday, May 17th. There are three Board of Education seats open for election. Two seats are uncontested, while Klu Padu and Juliete L. Gaebel are running for the board seat currently held by Joan Glase. Please exercise your right to vote on that day to determine the future direction of the Sullivan West Schools and our students.

Proposition 1

RESOLVED that the Board of Education of the Sullivan West Central School District, Sullivan County, New York, shall be authorized to expend the sum set forth in the budget for the 2016-2017 school year in the total amount of **\$36,350,468** and to assess and levy upon the taxable property for the District the necessary tax therefore.

Proposition 2

Shall the Board of Education of the Sullivan West Central School District be authorized to establish a Capital Reserve Fund, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3651 of the New York State Education Law, for the purpose of financing, in whole or in part, the cost of authorized alterations, construction or reconstruction of facilities, buildings or additions, and to fund this Reserve in the ultimate amount of five million dollars (\$5,000,000.), with annual appropriations to be determined by the Board of Education from the District's undesignated fund balance, for a probable term of ten (10) years, beginning on June 30, 2016 and ending on June 30, 2026?
