New York State Proficiency – advancement in knowledge or skill

Cohorts – a group of individuals having a statistical factor (as age or class membership) in common in a demographic study <a *cohort* of high school students all entering 9th grade in the same school year

Growth – progressive development

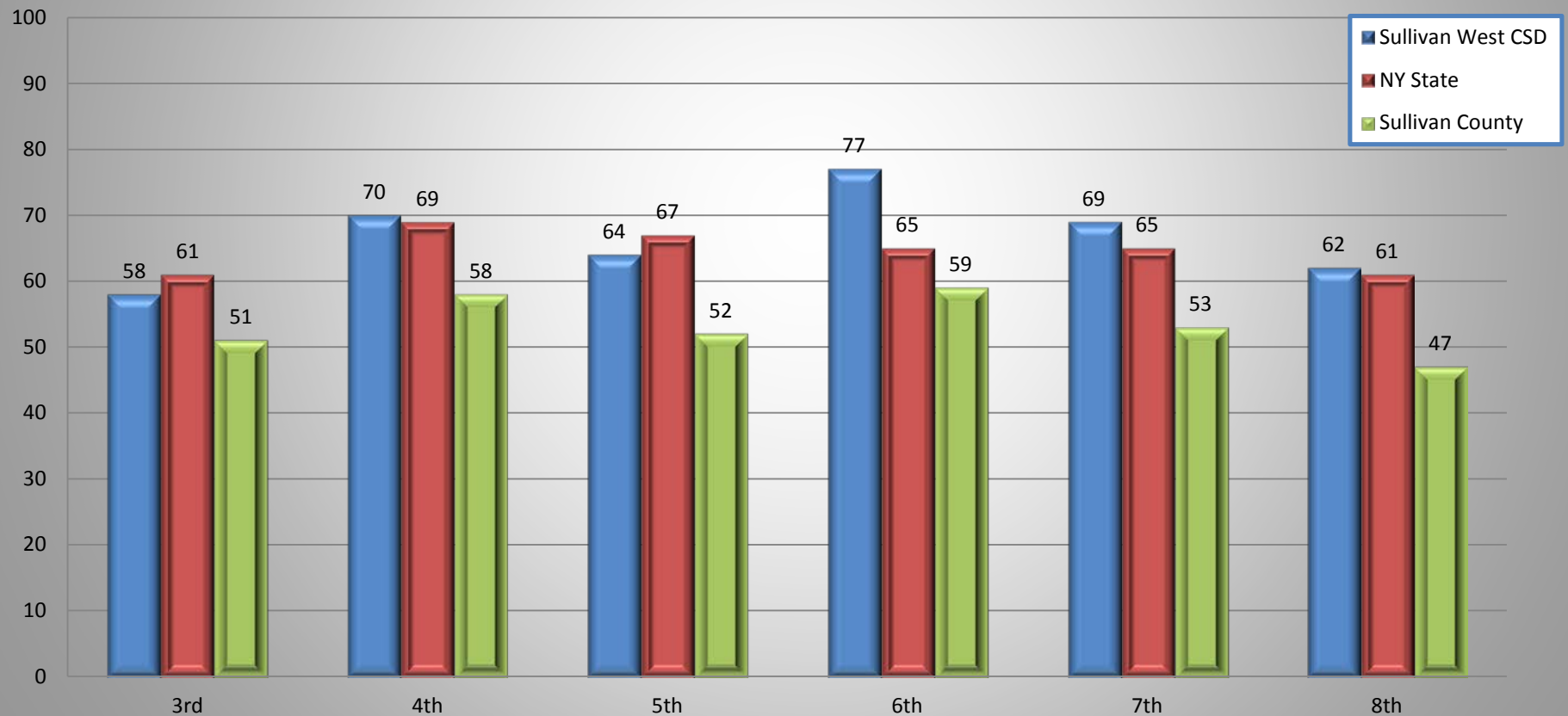

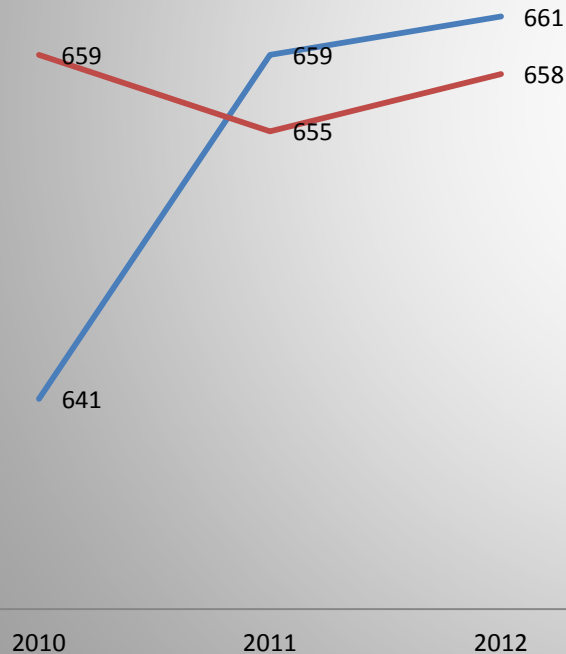

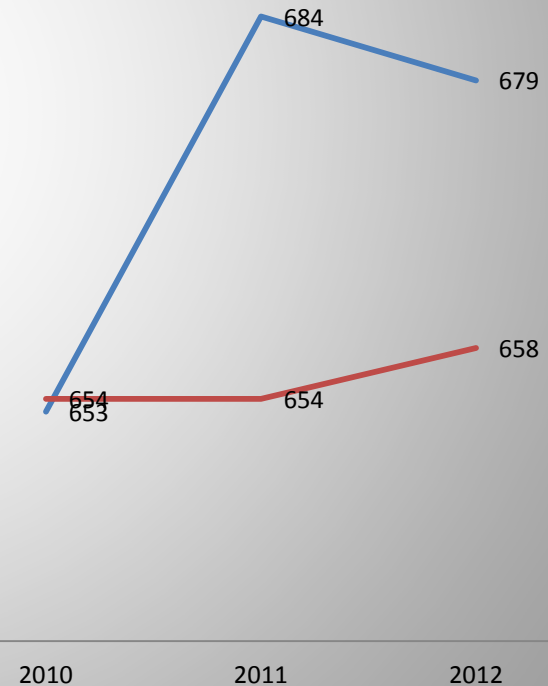

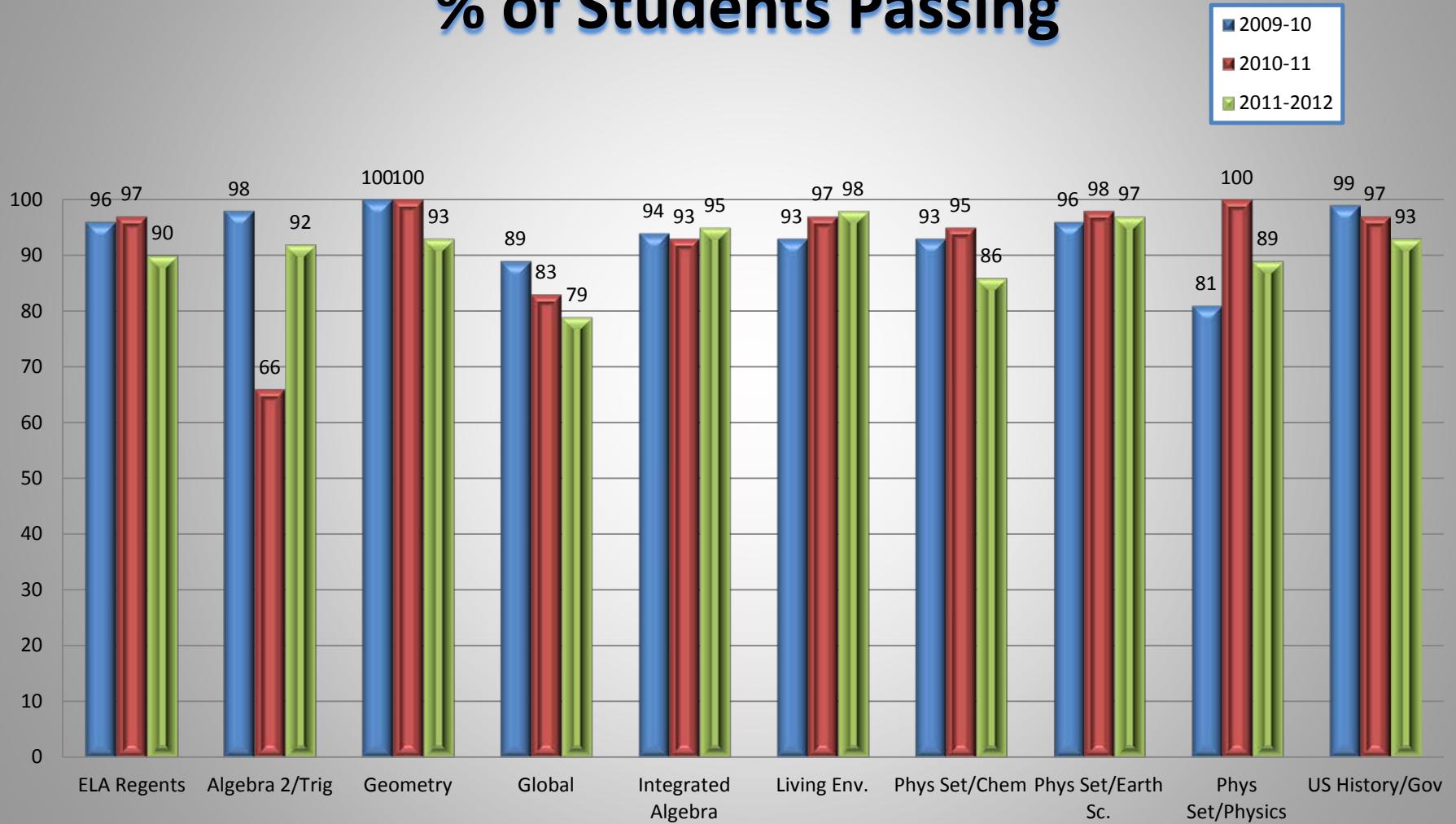

2004-2007 Sullivan County Cohort Graduation Rate %

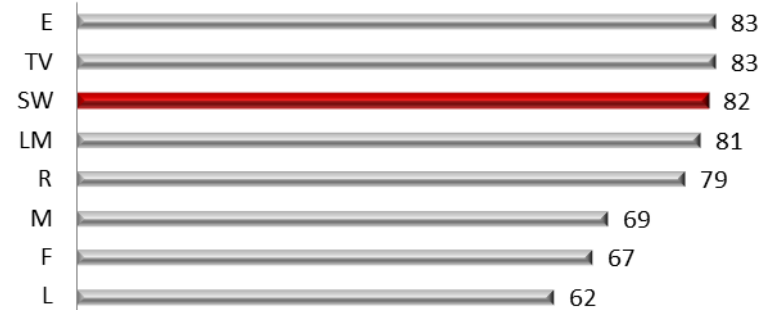

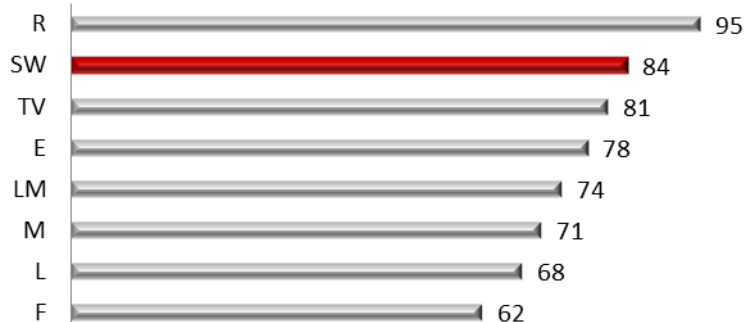

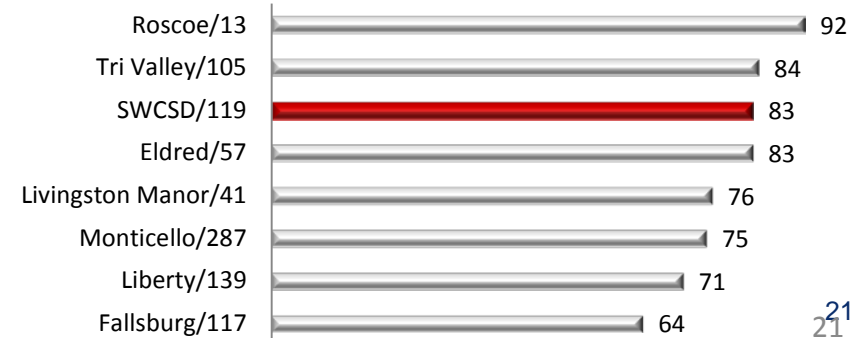
