WHEREAS, Section 2023-a of the New York Education Law (a central component of what is commonly known as the "Tax Cap" law) limits the amount of revenue that public school districts can raise through the school tax levy to fund school programs and activities, unless 60% of a school district voters (i.e. a supermajority) who are present and vote on the proposed school district budget for the ensuing school year approve the budget and thereby authorize the district's board of education to exceed the tax levy limit; and WHEREAS, the tax levy limit varies from district-to-district based on a formula set forth in law; and WHEREAS, the tax levy limit that is currently applicable to the Sullivan West Central School District (the "District"), with respect to the District's proposed budget for the ensuing 2016-2017 school year, is a "negative" tax levy limit; and

WHEREAS, this negative tax levy limit means that even if a majority of the District's voters approve the District's proposed budget for the 2016-2017 school year, the District will be required by law to reduce the overall school tax levy for the ensuing school year, below the amount of the overall tax levy that was issued for the current 2015-2016 school year; and

WHEREAS, on a practical level, the negative tax levy limit faced by District means that even if District spending remains flat under the proposed District budget, the District will have fewer tax dollars available to fund next year's budget with than were available to fund this year's budget; and

WHEREAS, the District's Board of Education (the "Board") has been made aware, through the advocacy of the New York State School Boards Association (NYSSBA), that legislation is pending in both the state Senate and Assembly which would eliminate the possibility of any school district being subjected to a "negative" tax levy limit, if the pending legislation becomes law; and

WHEREAS, the Board understands the need to control school spending and to contain the corresponding tax burden on the District's taxpayers; the Board also supports the efforts that are underway in the state Senate and Assembly to effectuate common sense reform to the Tax Cap law by amending the law to eliminate the specter of a "negative" tax levy limit for any school district; and

NOW, *THEREFORE*, *BE IT RESOLVED*, that the Board hereby endorses and expresses support for: Senate Bill S.7178, introduced by Senator Seward, and for Assembly Bill A.9792, introduced by Assemblywoman Lupardo, inasmuch as both bills propose to eliminate the "negative" tax levy limit; and
