CHILDREN'S MOBILE CRISIS INTERVENTION SERVICES OFFERS

The Children's Mobile Crisis Intervention Services Program operates during non-traditional business hours. It provides immediate assistance to children and their families when the child is experiencing a crisis.

A certified Social Worker is available to provide guidance and support via telephone. If clinically necessary, the Social Worker will travel to the home and provide one on one intervention. We make every effort to arrive as quietly and unobtrusively as possible.

OUR MISSION

Our mission is to assist Sullivan County families in times of crisis with their child to prevent a psychiatric hospitalization.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

To be eligible the child must be:

- Under the age of 18
- Residing in Sullivan County with a parent or guardian
- Diagnosed or presumed to have a Developmental Disability and/or a Serious Emotional Disturbance.
